DO I NEED TO PURCHASE A COMPUTER?

Having a personal computer is convenient, but before you buy a new one, check with your specific college to see if your program has computer and software requirements. it.wvu.edu/computer

WINDOWS OR MAC?

WVU supports both! Unless your major has specific computer requirements, we recommend using what you're comfortable with. You can even download Windows 10 for free and install it on your Mac using Apple's Boot Camp utility. Find instructions at support.apple.com/boot-camp.

DOES WVU HAVE A COMPUTER PURCHASING PROGRAM?

No. Students can purchase select high-performance laptops through a partnership with Dell, but the University does not sell or fix computers. Students are encouraged to use a computer that works with their budget and program requirements.

No. MyPrinting provides direct and web-based printing. Students can go to any campuswide MyPrinting location and swipe their WVU ID to pay with Mountie Bounty (wvucard.wvu.edu). If you want a personal printer, it **must** have a wired USB connection, and wireless capabilities **must** be disabled. myprinting.wvu.edu
